we cordially invite you to our Online-conference "**Stop Femicides! Effective against killings of women* and girls in the European Union**".

When: Friday, November 6th 2020 /// 09:00 – 17:00 (Berlin time)

All over the world, 137 women are killed every day by a member of their own family or their ex-partner, simply for being women.¹ This is around **50,000 victims** per year – the number of unreported cases is significantly higher.

On the occasion of the *International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women* on November 25th and the meeting of EU Gender Equality Ministers, DaMigra is organizing an international round table of experts on femicides, on November 6th in cooperation with the **Representation of the European Commission in Germany**. In the framework of the event, a common European strategy for the protection against violence and the implementation of the Istanbul Convention will be discussed.

In this context, we ask the following questions:

- What measures exist and how effective are they in the respective countries at combating femicides?
- What protection and support measures are European states obligated to take in accordance with the Istanbul Convention to prevent the murder of women?
- Which tools and measures are suited to end this crime against humanity in 21st-century-Europe?

The event takes place in four languages: German, English, Italian and Portuguese.
